On July 1, 2011, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) filed revised tariff sheets in compliance with the Commission's March 14, 2011 order. The revised tariff sheets reflect an updated timetable for the phased implementation of intra-hour (*i.e.*, 15-minute) transaction scheduling at NYISO proxy buses at the Chateauguay interface. The filing is in satisfactory compliance with the March 14 order.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the NYISO's submittal is accepted for filing, effective July 27, 2011, as requested.
