On October 12, 2012, New York Independent System Operator, Inc (NYISO) filed an errata to correct the tariff section base document used to create the clean and blacklined version of Section 5.14 of NYISO's Services Tariff in Docket No. ER12-360-000 Services Tariff) <sup>1</sup> that the Commission accepted in its October 6, 2011 delegated letter order in Docket No. ER11-2224-010.
