Dear Mr. Bissell:

On June 8, 2017 and on July 18, 2017, New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) submitted compliance filings specifying the proposed effective dates for tariff revisions accepted in the April 14, 2017 delegated letter order in this proceeding.¹

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307 (2017), your submittals are accepted for filing, effective on June 22, 2017 and August 1, 2017, as requested.

The filing was noticed on June 9, 2017, and July 19, 2017, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before June 29, 2017 and August 8, 2017, respectively. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2017)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.
