On August 16, 2018, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) submitted its compliance filing to remove language from sections 31.2.8.2.1, 31.2.8.2.2, 31.2.8.2.5, and 31.2.8.2.6 of Attachment Y¹ of its Open Access Transmission Tariff, as directed by the Commission in its July 25, 2018 order.²

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307 (2018), your submittal is accepted for filing, effective October 18, 2017, as requested.

The filing was noticed on August 16, 2018, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before September 6, 2018. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2018)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713 (2018).
