On October 16, 2018, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) submitted tariff revisions in compliance with the Commission's January 30, 2017 Order¹ and May 12, 2017 Order.² NYISO submits this filing to provide notice of an effective date of October 31, 2018, for the tariff amendments to comply with Order No. 745.³
