Reference: Proposed Tariff Revisions to Implement a New York City Operating
Reserves Region

On April 26, 2019, you submitted, on behalf of the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO), revisions to NYISO's Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff and Open Access Transmission Tariff to implement a new locational Operating Reserves region for New York City (i.e., Load Zone J).¹

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307 (2018), your submittal is accepted for filing, effective June 26, 2019, as requested.

The filing was noticed on April 26, 2019, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before May 17, 2019. Pursuant to Rule 214, 18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2018), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.
