On October 1, 2019, New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) and Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (National Grid) (Joint Filing Parties) filed an executed Large Generator Interconnection Agreement entered into among NYISO, National Grid, and Cassadaga Wind LLC (Cassadaga). The Joint Filing Parties state that the filing contains non-conforming language, including limited operation of the Cassadaga facility pending certain upgrades, and ministerial changes.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307 (2019), your submittal is accepted for filing, effective September 17, 2019, as requested.

The filing was noticed on October 1, 2019, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before October 22, 2019. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2019)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.
