On June 26, 2020, New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) submitted, on behalf of New York Transco, LLC, (NY Transco), revisions to NYISO's Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT)¹ to comply with the terms of the settlement agreement approved by the Commission on November 16, 2017, in this proceeding.² Section 3.10 of the settlement agreement stipulated that, if NY Transco was selected to build any portion of the projects defined in the settlement agreement as the AC Transmission Projects, NY Transco would make a compliance filing within 30 days of the date that the NYISO makes its selection. NY Transco states that these tariff revisions copy the Commission-approved cost allocation provisions for Segment B of the AC Transmission Projects to Appendix E of Attachment Y of the NYISO OATT. The tariff revisions satisfactorily comply with the requirements of the settlement agreement and the Commission's November 16, 2017 Order in this proceeding.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
