Reference: Proposed Tariff Revisions to Modify Eligibility to Utilize Meter Services Entities

On December 7, 2020, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) filed revisions to its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff to modify market participant eligibility to utilize Meter Services Entities.¹ The proposed tariff amendments will permit Demand Response Providers and Demand Side Ancillary Services Program providers to become Meter Services Entities or to procure metering and meter data services from approved Meter Services Entities.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307 (2020), your submittal is accepted for filing, effective February 8, 2021, as requested.

The filing was noticed on December 7, 2020, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before December 28, 2020. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2020)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.

referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders that have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against NYISO.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713 (2020).
