On December 1, 2020, in accordance with the requirements of the Commission's April 18, 2019 order¹ and February 6, 2020 letter order in this proceeding,² New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) filed revisions to its Open Access Transmission Tariff and its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff to reflect December 15, 2020 as the effective date of its Fast-Start Pricing Revisions.³ The compliance filing satisfactorily complies with the Commission's requirements.
