On June 29, 2021, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) filed compliance filings to provide notice of the expected effective date of the revisions to its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff¹ (Services Tariff) and to remove revisions to the Services Tariff as directed by the Commission.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective July 13, 2021, as requested.²

Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be
