On August 17, 2021, as amended on November 5, 2021, New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) filed, on behalf of LS Power Grid New York Corporation I (LSPGNY), revised tariff records under the NYISO Open Access Transmission Tariff (NYISO OATT) to comply with the requirements in the Commission's order¹ in this proceeding directing NYISO to submit revised tariff records in eTariff format.² The revised tariff records satisfactorily comply with the requirements of the June 17, 2021 Order.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307 (2020), your submittals are accepted for filing, effective May 27, 2020, as requested, consistent with the revised tariff records accepted effective May 27, 2020, in the June 17, 2021 Order.

The filings were publicly noticed on August 17, 2021, and November 5, 2021, with interventions and protests due on or before September 7, 2021, and November 26, 2021, respectively. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2020)), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted. Granting a late intervention at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties. No protests or adverse comments were filed.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed document(s); nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against NYISO or LSPGNY.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713 (2020).
