On March 24, 2023, New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) submitted revisions to section 2.17 of NYISO's Open Access Transmission Tariff¹ and section 5.1.2 of NYISO's Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff² in compliance with the directives in a Commission order issued on February 23, 2023³ regarding the cybersecurity and parallel flow visualization related requirements of Order No. 676-J.⁴ The revisions are in satisfactory compliance with the February Order. Pursuant to authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, the submittal is accepted for filing, effective February 23, 2023, as requested.

The filing was publicly noticed. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 385.214), notices of intervention, timely-filed motions to intervene, and any unopposed motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted.
