On October 12, 2012, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) filed tariff revisions in compliance with the Commission's March 14, 2011 order.¹ The revisions reflect an updated timetable for the phased implementation of intra-hour (i.e., 15-minute) transaction scheduling at the PJM Neptune proxy generation bus. This filing is in satisfactory compliance with the March 14 order.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - East, under 18 C.F.R. §375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective October 30, 2012 as requested.

The filing was noticed on October 12, 2012, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before November 2, 2012. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2011)), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted. Granting late interventions at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of the

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
