NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF TIME

On September 24, 2010, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) filed a motion for an extension of time to comply with the Commission's Order on Rehearing, Clarification, and Compliance issued June 30, 2009, in the above-referenced proceeding.¹ In its motion, the NYISO requests an extension of time to April 4, 2011, to make a compliance filing regarding the criteria for new capacity zones and addressing the implications and effects of a new capacity zone or zones on the tariff provisions and market rule governing Capacity Resource Interconnection Service. On October 1, 2010, CPV Valley, LLC, the Dynegy Parties,² Entergy Nuclear Power Marketing, LLC, and the Mirant Parties³ filed a joint answer opposing the requested extension.
