Reference: Small Generator Interconnection Agreement, Agreement No. 2608

On April 28, 2021, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) and Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (National Grid) (together, the Joint Filing Parties) submitted for filing a Small Generator Interconnection Agreement entered into by the NYISO, National Grid, and SunEast Skyline Solar LLC (SunEast).¹ The Joint Filing Parties state that the filing contains non-conforming language, including that SunEast will be responsible for constructing the Connecting Transmission Owner's Interconnection Facilities associated with the Facility.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal is accepted for filing, effective April 15, 2021, as requested.

The filing was noticed on April 28, 2021, with comments, interventions, and protests due on or before May 19, 2021. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214), to the extent that any timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time were filed before the issuance date of this order, such interventions are granted.
