**Re: *LS Power Grid New York Corporation I*, Docket No. ER20-716-000 – Notice of Erroneous Attachment Submittal**

Dear Secretary Bose:

On December 31, 2019, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”), in its role as the tariff administrator, submitted a filing on behalf of LS Power Grid New York Corporation I (“LSPG-NY”) in the above-referenced docket.<sup>1</sup> Among other matters, the filing proposed to establish a new Attachment 1 (Section 6.10.6) to Rate Schedule 10 of the NYISO Open Access Transmission Tariff (“OATT”). After submission of the filing on LSPG-NY’s behalf, the NYISO identified an inadvertent administrative error with respect to the documents submitted as part of the filing. Specifically, the NYISO erroneously included a document identified as “Attachment I” as part of the filing.

**I. Notice of Erroneous Attachment**

It has come to the NYISO’s attention that the filing submitted on LSPG-NY’s behalf erroneously included a document identified as “Attachment I.”<sup>2</sup> This attachment is wholly unrelated to the filing and is not otherwise referenced in the balance of the documents submitted on LSPG-NY’s behalf.<sup>3</sup>

The inadvertent inclusion of this erroneous attachment has no impact on any other aspect of LSPG-NY’s filing, including, but not limited to, the proposed revisions to the OATT set forth

in Attachment A. Accordingly, the NYISO respectfully requests that the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) and all interested parties disregard this erroneous attachment.

The NYISO will send an electronic link to this filing to the official representative of each party to this proceeding, the official representative of each of its customers, each participant on its stakeholder committees, the New York State Public Service Commission, and the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities. The NYISO will also post the complete filing on its website at [www.nyiso.com](http://www.nyiso.com).

## **III. Conclusion**

The NYISO respectfully requests that the Commission accept this filing to provide notice of the erroneous attachment (*i.e.*, Attachment I) that was inadvertently included as part of the December 31, 2019 filing submitted on behalf of LSPG-NY in this proceeding.
