Re: *New York Independent System Operator, Inc.*; Supplemental Notice of Delayed Effective Date, Docket No. ER21-625-00_

Dear Secretary Bose:

In accordance with the requirements of the January 28, 2021 order issued by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) in this proceeding (“January 28 Order”),¹ on May 25, 2021, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”) submitted an initial notice to specify the intended effective date for the proposed revisions to its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff (“Services Tariff”) that were accepted by the January 28 Order (“May 25 Notice”).²

On June 7, 2021, the NYISO provided notice of its intent to delay the implementation of the changes until the June 10, 2021 market day (“June 7 Notice”).³ Based on current system conditions and forecasted hot weather conditions this week, the NYISO hereby provides notice that it intends to further delay the implementation of the changes until the June 17, 2021 market day.

I. Documents Submitted

The NYISO respectfully submits the following with this filing letter:

1. A clean version of the revisions to the Services Tariff accepted by the January 28 Order reflecting an updated effective date of June 17, 2021 (“Attachment I”).

II. Supplemental Notice of Delay of Effective Date

The May 25 Notice indicated that if the NYISO subsequently determined that it would be unable to implement the changes accepted by the January 28 Order on June 8, 2021, the NYISO

would provide a follow-up notice to the Commission.⁴ The June 7 Notice indicated the NYISO's initial intent to slightly delay implementation to the June 10, 2021 market day.⁵ However, based on current system conditions and the forecasted hot weather conditions expected to persist through a portion of this week, the NYISO will further delay the implementation of the changes accepted by the January 28 Order until the June 17, 2021 market day.⁶

III. Service

The NYISO will send an electronic link to this filing to the official representative of each party to this proceeding, the official representative of each of its customers, each participant on its stakeholder committees, the New York State Public Service Commission, and the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities. In addition, the NYISO will post this filing on its website at www.nyiso.com.

IV. Conclusion

The NYISO respectfully requests that the Commission accept this filing.

Should the NYISO subsequently determine that it will be unable to implement these tariff revisions on the June 17, 2021 market day, it will promptly notify its Market Participants and the Commission.
