**Re: Docket No. ER23-1863-00\_, New York Independent System Operator, Inc.;  
Notice of Updated Effective Date**

Dear Secretary Bose:

On May 11, 2023, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”) filed proposed revisions to its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff (“Services Tariff”) to implement enhancements to its transmission constraint pricing logic.<sup>1</sup> The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) issued an order on July 6, 2023 accepting the NYISO’s proposal (“July 6 Order”).<sup>2</sup>

The July 6 Order directed the NYISO to submit a subsequent filing to specify the effective date for the proposed enhancements.<sup>3</sup> On September 26, 2023, the NYISO submitted an initial notice of its anticipated effective date for the tariff revisions accepted by the July 6 Order (“September 26 Notice”).<sup>4</sup> The NYISO submitted a supplemental filing on October 6, 2023 to inform the Commission of a need to delay the anticipated effective date set forth in the September 26 Notice.<sup>5</sup> The NYISO submits this filing to provide an updated effective date for the applicable tariff revisions.

**I. Notice of Updated Effective Date**

In compliance with the July 6 Order, the NYISO provides notice that it expects to implement the tariff revisions accepted by the Commission on November 14, 2023.<sup>6</sup> The
