Dear Ethan:

The NYISO is sunsetting the Day-Ahead Demand Response Program (DADRP) and Demand Side Ancillary Services Program (DSASP) as part of the transition to the Distributed Energy Resource (DER) and Aggregation participation model. The NYISO expected to sunset the DADRP and DSASP in April 2025. The NYISO has determined that sufficient cause exists to postpone the sunset of the DSASP and DADRP until October 31, 2025.

The new sunset date of October 31, 2025 aligns with the end of the 2025 Summer Capability Period and will allow more time for Aggregators, Transmission Owners, and the NYISO to complete the necessary work to transition DSASP Resources to the DER and Aggregation participation model.
