**Re: New York Independent System Operator, Inc. and
Niagara Mohawk Power Corp.
Docket No. ER26-589-000
Compliance Filing to Incorporate Accepted Tariff Revisions**

Dear Secretary Reese:

The New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”), as administrator of the NYISO Open Access Transmission Tariff (“OATT” or “Tariff”), submits via eTariff on behalf of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation (“NMPC”)¹ this compliance filing to incorporate revisions to NMPC’s Wholesale Transmission Service Charge (“TSC”) formula rate template under Attachment H to the NYISO OATT² accepted by Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC” or “Commission”) orders issued on December 15, 2025 (“December 15 Order”),³ and January 13, 2026 (“January 13 Order”),⁴ respectively.

The December 15 Order accepted proposed revisions to NMPC’s TSC formula rate and formula rate template to incorporate updates to NMPC’s stated depreciation rates and implement new accounts established under the Commission’s Order No. 898.⁵ The January 13 Order, among other things, accepted proposed revisions to NMPC’s TSC formula rate template to enable NMPC to recover the costs of transmission projects it is developing in support of New York State public policy goals (the “NMPC Phase 2 Projects”). NMPC submitted the filing accepted in the January 13 Order on November 24, 2025 (“November 24 Filing”), prior to issuance of the December 15 Order. As such, the version of NMPC’s TSC formula rate template submitted in the November 24 Filing did not include the changes accepted by the Commission in the December 15 Order.

NMPC proposes conforming tariff revisions in this filing to ensure the currently effective version of its TSC formula rate template incorporates all changes accepted by the Commission in the December 15 and January 13 Orders. NMPC respectfully requests that Commission accept the revisions proposed in this filing to be effective January 24, 2026, consistent with the effective date established by the Commission in the January 13 Order.

I. COMPLIANCE FILING

On October 27, 2025, the NYISO submitted revisions to NMPC's TSC formula rate and formula rate template under the NYISO OATT on NMPC's behalf in Docket No. ER26-266-000 ("October 27 Filing"). The revisions proposed in the October 27 Filing aligned the depreciation rates set forth in NMPC's TSC formula rate with the depreciation rates approved in its most recent New York State Public Service Commission retail rate case and updated references in NMPC's TSC formula rate template to reflect changes required by the Commission in Order No. 898.⁶ The revisions submitted in Docket No. ER26-266-000 were accepted by the Commission in the December 15 Order and, while both sets of revisions reside in Attachment H to the NYISO OATT, the revisions accepted in the December 15 Order are unrelated to the revisions accepted in the January 13 Order.

In the November 24 Filing, NMPC proposed revisions to its TSC formula rate template to support NMPC's recovery of an annual transmission revenue requirement related to the NMPC Phase 2 Projects.⁷ Because the revisions proposed in the October 27 Filing were still pending at the time NMPC submitted the November 24 Filing, NMPC committed to submit a conforming compliance filing to reflect all changes to Niagara Mohawk's TSC formula rate template accepted following Commission action on both filings. Consistent with this commitment, NMPC proposes conforming revisions to its TSC formula rate template in this filing to reflect the changes accepted by the Commission in the December 15 and January 13 Orders.

II. PROPOSED EFFECTIVE DATE

Consistent with the effective date established by the Commission in the January 13 Order,⁸ NMPC requests an effective date of January 24, 2026, for the conforming revisions to its TSC formula rate template under Attachment H to the NYISO OATT proposed herein.
