Dear Ms. Reese:

On June 27, 2025, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”) submitted, in the above-captioned docket, its compliance filing and request for waivers of certain North American Energy Standards Board (“NAESB”) Wholesale Electric Quadrant (“WEQ”) business practice standards as set forth in Commission Order No. 676-K. In accordance with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission’s (“Commission”) March 27, 2026, *Order on Compliance and Request for Waivers* (the “March 2026 Order”),<sup>1</sup> the NYISO hereby submits this compliance filing revising Section 2.17 of the NYISO’s Open Access Transmission Tariff (“OATT”) and Section 5.1.2 of the NYISO’s Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff (“Services Tariff”).

The revisions submitted in this compliance filing are limited in scope. In the March 2026 Order, the Commission noted that the NYISO’s tariff records included a placeholder for the citation to the Order granting the waiver requests and directed the NYISO to submit a compliance filing within 60 days to revise its tariff records to include that citation. Accordingly, the NYISO submits this filing solely to replace the placeholder “[Order]” with the full citation to the March 2026 Order, “*New York Independent System Operator, Inc.*, 194 FERC ¶ 61,235 (March 27, 2026),” and makes no other changes.
