Independent System Operator, Inc.'s Open Access Transmission Tariff, Docket
No. ER26-_____

Dear Ms. Reese:

Pursuant to Section 205(d) of the Federal Power Act¹ and Sections 35.9 and 35.15 of the Commission's regulations,² the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. ("NYISO") hereby tenders for filing and acceptance a Notice of Cancellation of the Small Generator Interconnection Agreement ("Agreement") for the Hyland Landfill project (NYISO Queue Position No. 209A) among the NYISO, Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("RG&E") as the Connecting Transmission Owner, and Casella Waste Systems, Inc. ("Casella") as the Interconnection Customer (collectively, the "Parties"). The Agreement is designated as Service Agreement No. 1367 of the NYISO's Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT").

I. Background

The Agreement concerns the Interconnection Customer's Hyland Landfill Generation Facility ("Facility"), which was a 6.4 MW generating facility located in Angelica, New York and interconnected to RG&E's transmission system. The Agreement was fully executed by the Parties on August 25, 2008. The Agreement included certain non-conforming revisions to the NYISO's *pro forma* Small Generator Interconnection Agreement ("Pro Forma SGIA") located in Attachment Z of the NYISO OATT, which non-conforming revisions were filed with, and accepted by, the Commission.³

II. Notice of Cancellation

Article 3.3.1 of the Agreement provides that the "Interconnection Customer may terminate this Agreement at any time by giving the NYISO and Transmission Owner 20 Business Days written notice." Article 3.3 further provides that the termination of the agreement will not be effective "until the Parties have complied with all Applicable Laws and Regulations

applicable to such termination, including the filing with FERC of a notice of termination of this Agreement (if required), which notice has been accepted for filing by FERC.”

On May 20, 2025, Casella provided written notice of termination of the Agreement to the NYISO and RG&E (“Termination Notice”) and the twenty-day notice period has been satisfied. A copy of the Termination Notice is included as Attachment I.

Therefore, pursuant to Article 3.3 of the Agreement, the Agreement is terminated, subject to the Commission accepting this notice terminating the Agreement. Accordingly, the NYISO hereby submits this Notice of Cancellation of Service Agreement No. 1367 of the NYISO OATT for the Commission’s acceptance.

III. Requested Effective Date

The NYISO respectfully requests that the proposed cancellation become effective on August 11, 2026 (*i.e.*, the day after the end of the statutory 60-day notice period).
