**Re: *New York Independent System Operator, Inc.*; Notice of Effective Date
and Compliance Filing, Docket No. ER25-1998-00_**

Dear Secretary Reese:

On April 18, 2025, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”) filed proposed revisions (“April 2025 Filing”)¹ to its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff (“Services Tariff”) to implement additional operating reserve procurement requirements throughout the New York Control Area (“NYCA”) to account for anticipated forecast uncertainties in both the Day-Ahead Market and Real-Time Market (*i.e.*, “Uncertainty Reserve Requirements”). On July 2, 2025, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) issued an order accepting the NYISO’s proposed Uncertainty Reserves Requirements (“July 2025 Order”).²

The July 2025 Order directed the NYISO to submit a subsequent filing to provide no less than two weeks’ notice of the expected effective date for the tariff revisions accepted by the Commission.³ The NYISO submits this compliance filing to provide notice of the expected effective date for the revisions to the Services Tariff that were accepted by the July 2025 Order.

I. Documents Submitted

The NYISO respectfully submits the following with this filing letter:

1. A clean version of the revisions to the Services Tariff accepted by the July 2025 Order with an effective date of September 2, 2026 (“Attachment I”).

II. Notice of Effective Date

In compliance with the July 2025 Order, the NYISO hereby provides notice to the Commission that it expects to implement the revisions to the Services Tariff accepted by the July 2025 Order on September 2, 2026.⁴ For the Day-Ahead Market, the Services Tariff revisions will be incorporated into the execution of the Day-Ahead Market occurring on September 3, 2026 for the September 4, 2026 market day. For the Real-Time Market, the Services Tariff revisions will introduce the real-time Uncertainty Reserve Requirement calculation on September 3, 2026, with Uncertainty Reserve Requirements being incorporated into the entire dispatch day of September 4, 2026, for the first time.

III. Service

The NYISO will send an electronic link to this filing to the official representative of each party to this proceeding, the official representative of each of its customers, each participant on its stakeholder committees, the New York State Public Service Commission, and the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities. In addition, the NYISO will post this filing on its website at www.nyiso.com.

IV. Conclusion

The NYISO respectfully submits this filing in compliance with the July 2025 Order.
