Re: *New York Independent System Operator, Inc.*; Notice of Effective Date and Compliance Filing, Docket Nos. ER25-2382-00_ and ER26-2567-00_

Dear Secretary Reese:

On May 30, 2025, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”) filed proposed revisions (“May 2025 Filing”)¹ to its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff (“Services Tariff”) to: (1) enhance the modeling of combined cycle gas turbine (“CCGT”) generators with duct-firing capability; and (2) expand opportunities for CCGT generators with duct-firing capability to provide Energy and Ancillary Services consistent with their physical operating capabilities. On July 25, 2025, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) issued an order accepting the NYISO’s proposed enhancements for CCGT generators with duct-firing capability (“July 2025 Order”).²

On May 18, 2026, the NYISO submitted additional proposed revisions to its Services Tariff to support the wholesale market participation opportunities for CCGT generators equipped with duct-firing capability (“May 2026 Filing”).³ The May 2026 Filing was submitted in accordance with Section 205 of the Federal Power Act and Part 35 of the Commission’s regulation and was necessary to clarify and enhance the improvements that were previously submitted to and accepted by the Commission, in the May 2025 Filing and July 2025 Order, respectively. On June 22, 2026, the Commission issued an order accepting the NYISO’s May 2026 Filing (“June 2026 Order”).⁴

The July 2025 Order and June 2026 Order directed the NYISO to submit a subsequent filing to provide no less than two weeks' notice of the expected effective date for the tariff revisions accepted by the Commission. The NYISO submits this compliance filing to provide notice of the expected effective date for the revisions to the Services Tariff that were accepted by the July 2025 Order and the June 2026 Order.⁵

I. Documents Submitted

The NYISO respectfully submits the following with this filing letter:

1. A clean version of the revisions to the Services Tariff accepted by the July 2025 Order with an effective date of September 2, 2026 ("Attachment I").

II. Notice of Effective Date

In compliance with the July 2025 Order and the June 2026 Order, the NYISO hereby provides notice to the Commission that it expects to implement the revisions to the Services Tariff accepted by the two orders on September 2, 2026.⁶

The NYISO will send an electronic link to this filing to the official representative of each party to this proceeding, the official representative of each of its customers, each participant on its stakeholder committees, the New York State Public Service Commission, and the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities.
