Re: Notice of Cancellation of Service Agreement No. 2681 to the New York Independent System Operator, Inc.'s Open Access Transmission Tariff, Docket No. ER26-_____

Dear Ms. Reese:

Pursuant to Section 205(d) of the Federal Power Act¹ and Sections 35.9 and 35.15 of the Commission's regulations,² the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. ("NYISO") hereby tenders for filing and acceptance a Notice of Cancellation of the Small Generator Interconnection Agreement ("Agreement") for the NY 13 Solar project (NYISO Queue Position No. 855) among the NYISO, Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid ("National Grid") as the Connecting Transmission Owner, and Bald Mountain Solar LLC ("Bald Mountain") as the Interconnection Customer (collectively, the "Parties"). The Agreement is designated as Service Agreement No. 2681 of the NYISO's Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT").

I. Background

The Agreement concerns the interconnection of Bald Mountain's proposed 20 MW solar generating facility to National Grid's transmission system. The Agreement was fully executed by the Parties on February 10, 2022. The Agreement included certain non-conforming revisions to the NYISO's *pro forma* Small Generator Interconnection Agreement ("Pro Forma SGIA") located in Attachment Z of the NYISO OATT, which non-conforming revisions were filed with, and accepted by, the Commission.³

II. Notice of Cancellation

Article 3.3.1 of the Agreement provides that the "Interconnection Customer may terminate this Agreement at any time by giving the NYISO and Connecting Transmission Owner 20 Business Days written notice." Article 3.3 further provides that the termination of the agreement will not be effective "until the Parties have complied with all Applicable Laws and

Regulations applicable to such termination, including the filing with FERC of a notice of termination of this Agreement (if required), which notice has been accepted for filing by FERC.”

On May 6, 2026, Bald Mountain provided written notice via email to the NYISO and National Grid that it was acting pursuant to Article 3.3.1 to terminate the Agreement (“Termination Notice”).⁴ A copy of the Termination Notice is included as Attachment I.⁵ The twenty (20) Business Day period was completed on June 4, 2026. The parties have confirmed that there are no remaining obligations under the Agreement.⁶

Therefore, pursuant to Article 3.3 of the Agreement, the Agreement is terminated, subject to the Commission accepting this notice terminating the Agreement. Accordingly, the NYISO hereby submits this Notice of Cancellation of Service Agreement No. 2681 of the NYISO OATT for the Commission’s acceptance.

III. Requested Effective Date

The NYISO respectfully requests that the proposed cancellation become effective on October 14, 2026 (*i.e.*, the day after the end of the statutory 60-day notice period).

In a July 20, 2026, email, Bald Mountain (through its parent company – Boralex) informed the NYISO and National Grid that it authorized the disclosure of the Termination Notice “to the extent necessary for purposes of the termination process, including any required regulatory, administrative, or other related filings.” This email is attached as Attachment II.

⁶ Pursuant to Article 3.3.4 of the Agreement, the “termination of this Agreement shall not relieve any Party of its liabilities and obligations, owed or continuing at the time of the termination. The Interconnection Customer shall pay all amounts in excess of any deposit or other security without interest within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of the invoice for such amounts. If the deposit or other security exceeds the invoice, the Connecting Transmission Owner shall refund such excess within thirty (30) calendar days of the invoice without interest....”
