**Re: Docket No. ER26-____-000, *New York Independent System Operator, Inc.*;
Compliance Filing to Conform Tariff Records**

Dear Secretary Reese:

On August 24, 2026, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) issued an order in Docket No. ER26-2959 accepting certain revisions proposed by the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”) to its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff (“Services Tariff”) addressing the Installed Capacity (“ICAP”) market parameters for the upcoming 2026-2027 Winter Capability Period.¹

The NYISO submits this filing to incorporate the revisions accepted by the Commission in Docket No. ER26-2959 within updated tariff baseline versions of Sections 5.11 and 5.14 of the Services Tariff.² The updated tariff baselines reflect changes to such sections as a result of separate revisions accepted by the Commission in Docket No. ER26-1431 after the submission of the filing in Docket No. ER26-2959.³

I. Background

On June 25, 2026, the NYISO proposed revisions to the Services Tariff in Docket No. ER26-2959 to improve the ICAP market parameters for the upcoming 2026-2027 Winter Capability Period in response to potential misalignment that could otherwise arise from certain new resource entry.⁴ The NYISO proposed revisions to Sections 5.11 and 5.14 of the Services

Tariff as part of such filing. The Commission issued an order on August 24, 2026 accepting the proposed revisions in Docket No. ER26-2959 effective on August 25, 2026.⁵

Separately, on February 18, 2026, the NYISO proposed revisions to the Services Tariff to enhance the ICAP market rules in response to ongoing changes to New York's electric grid, including the emergence and expected growth of winter risks.⁶ This separate filing also included proposed revisions to Sections 5.11 and 5.14 of the Services Tariff. On June 26, 2026, the Commission issued an order accepting the NYISO's proposed revisions to the Services Tariff in Docket No. ER26-1431, which became effective on June 28, 2026.⁷

The proposed tariff revisions in Docket No. ER26-2959 were submitted prior to the Commission's issuance of the order accepting the revisions proposed in Docket No. ER26-1431. As a result, the then pending revisions in Docket No. ER26-1431 were not included in the tariff baseline versions of Section 5.11 and 5.14 of the Services Tariff submitted in Docket No. ER26-2959. The NYISO submits this filing to conform the Commission's eTariff records by incorporating the revisions accepted in Docket No. ER26-2959 into updated tariff baseline versions of Sections 5.11 and 5.14 of the Services Tariff reflecting the revisions accepted by the Commission in Docket No. ER26-1431.⁸ The tariff records submitted as part of this filing will improve the accuracy of the Commission's official eTariff records by providing versions of Sections 5.11 and 5.14 effective as of August 25, 2026 that properly reflect the Commission's action in both dockets.⁹
