On July 26, 2016, pursuant to Section 205 of the Federal Power Act,<sup>1</sup> and Part 35 of the Commission's regulations,<sup>2</sup> Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid ("National Grid") filed in this proceeding a Small Generator Interconnection Agreement ("SGIA") between National Grid and Innovative/Colonie, LLC, designated as Service Agreement No. 2293 under the New York Independent System Operator, Inc.'s Open Access Transmission Tariff.
