Pursuant to Rules 212 and 214 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (Commission) Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. §§ 385.212 & 385.214 (2012), the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) hereby moves to intervene in Docket No. RM18-1-000.

The NYISO is a not-for-profit corporation responsible for providing openaccess transmission service and administering open and competitive wholesale markets in New York State.
