Re: New York Independent System Operator, Inc., Errata to Incorporate Commission-Accepted Tariff Revisions; Docket No. ER20-1105-000

Dear Secretary Bose:

The New York Independent System Operator, Inc. ("NYISO") submits this errata to its February 27, 2020 Short-Term Reliability Process filing in Docket No. ER20-1105-000 ("STRP Filing"). The STRP Filing was proposed to better integrate the Generator Deactivation Process with the rest of the NYISO's Reliability Planning Process. The Commission's April 30, 2020 Order in the above Docket accepted the NYISO's filing, effective May 1, 2020.²

The as-filed clean and redline versions of Section 5.14 of the NYISO's Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff ("Services Tariff") that were included with the STRP Filing inadvertently omitted tariff revisions that the NYISO proposed in Docket No. ER20-1049-000. The Commission accepted the changes the NYISO proposed in Docket ER20-1049-000 with an effective date of April 22, 2020, which is prior to the effective date of the STRP Filing tariff revisions.³ This filing proposes to correct the record by adding the changes to Section 5.14 of the Services Tariff that the Commission accepted in Docket No. ER20-1049-000 to the STRP Filing revisions to that section of the Services Tariff.

- 3. A corrected clean version of the NYISO's Services Tariff Section 5.14 ("Attachment II") effective March 1, 2021 that includes the omitted text;
- 4. A corrected redlined version of the NYISO's Services Tariff Section 5.14 effective May 1, 2020 ("Attachment III"), identifying in redline format only the text that the Commission accepted in Docket No. ER20-1049-000, with an effective date of April 22, 2020, that the NYISO proposes to add to correct the record; and
- 5. A corrected redlined version of the NYISO's Services Tariff Section 5.14 effective March 1, 2021 ("Attachment IV"), identifying in redline format only the text that the Commission accepted in Docket No. ER20-1049-000, with an effective date of April 22, 2020, that the NYISO proposes to add to correct the record.

II. Errata

As outlined above, the NYISO proposes to replace the versions of Services Tariff Section 5.14 that were submitted as part of the STRP Filing with corrected versions. This errata filing simply inserts the omitted language from ER20-1049-000 into the section so that the tariff record is complete. There are no substantive revisions proposed in this errata filing and the omitted language has no material bearing on the language the Commission accepted in its April 30, 2020 order in Docket No. ER20-1105-000.

This errata to the NYISO's February 27 Filing will be posted on the NYISO's website at www.nyiso.com. In addition, the NYISO will e-mail an electronic link to this filing to the official representative of each party to this proceeding, to each of its customers, to each participant on its stakeholder committees, to the New York Public Service Commission, and to the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities.
