Dear Secretary Bose:

On December 11, 2020, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”) filed proposed revisions to its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff (“Services Tariff”) to implement certain enhancements to its reserve procurement practices within Southeastern New York (“SENY”).¹ On January 28, 2021, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) issued an order accepting the NYISO’s proposal (“January 28 Order”).²

The January 28 Order directed the NYISO to submit a subsequent compliance filing to provide notice of the expected effective date for the proposed enhancements at least “14 days prior to the date on which the revisions will become effective.”³ The NYISO submits this filing to provide notice of the expected effective date for the revisions to the Services Tariff that were accepted by the January 28 Order.

I. Documents Submitted

The NYISO respectfully submits the following with this filing letter:

1. A clean version of the revisions to the Services Tariff accepted by the January 28 Order with an effective date of June 8, 2021 (“Attachment I”).
