**Re: *New York Independent System Operator, Inc.*; Compliance Filing
Establishing Effective Date, Docket No. ER21-892-00_**

Dear Secretary Bose:

On January 15, 2021, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”) filed proposed revisions to its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff (“Services Tariff”) to enhance the NYISO’s operational control of solar resources in order to increase the NYISO’s ability to reliably and efficiently operate the New York Transmission System.¹ On March 10, 2021, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) issued an order accepting the NYISO’s proposal (“March 10 Order”).²

The March 10 Order accepted the NYISO’s proposed Services Tariff revisions “subject to NYISO making a compliance filing with revised tariff records no later than 14 days prior to the date on which the revisions will become effective.”³ The NYISO submits this compliance filing to provide notice of the expected effective date and tariff records for the revisions to the Services Tariff that were accepted by the March 10 Order.

I. Documents Submitted

The NYISO respectfully submits the following with this filing letter:

1. A clean version of the revisions to the Services Tariff accepted by the March 10 Order with an effective date of June 8, 2021 (“Attachment I”).
