**Re: *New York Independent System Operator, Inc.*; Notice of Effective Date
and Compliance Filing, Docket No. ER21-1001-00_**

Dear Secretary Bose:

On January 29, 2021, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”) filed proposed revisions to its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff (“Services Tariff”) and Open Access Transmission Tariff (“OATT”) to implement Co-located Storage Resources (“CSR”) in its Energy, Ancillary Services and Installed Capacity Markets (“CSR Filing”).¹ On March 30, 2021, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) issued an Order accepting the NYISO’s proposed CSR Tariff revisions (“CSR Order”).²

Consistent with PP 45-47 of the CSR Order, the NYISO made a subset of the CSR Tariff revisions effective on March 31, 2021. The remaining Tariff revisions, which implement the CSR rules in the NYISO’s Energy, Ancillary Services and Capacity Markets, were permitted to be implemented on a flexible effective date in the fourth quarter of 2021. The Commission directed the NYISO to “to submit a compliance filing with no less than two weeks’ notice of the proposed effective date, in the fourth quarter of 2021, for the remaining proposed tariff revisions in its CSR Participation Model.” Consistent with the Commission’s directive, the NYISO submits this compliance filing to provide notice of the expected effective date for the not-yet effective Services Tariff and OATT revisions.

In addition to the revisions described above, the NYISO submits certain ministerial corrections to the tariff sections that it submitted with its January 29, 2021 filing to become effective on March 31, 2021. Services Tariff Sections 23.2 and 23.3 were inadvertently assigned an effective date of March 30, 2021 in the eTariff system. They are resubmitted here with the correct March 31, 2021 effective date. In addition, OATT Section 30.14 was inadvertently filed with an incomplete base, omitting language that the NYISO filed and the Commission accepted

in Docket No. ER19-1949.³ OATT Section 30.14 is corrected and resubmitted with this filing to complete the language that should have been reflected in the March 31, 2021 effective date submission. Finally, CSR language in Services Tariff Section 13 that became effective on March 31, 2021 was inadvertently omitted from the version of that Tariff section that the NYISO filed on September 9, 2021 in Docket No. ER21-2883.⁴ Two omitted references to CSR are resubmitted with this filing to complete the language that should have been reflected in the November 13, 2021 effective date submission.

I. Documents Submitted

The NYISO respectfully submits the following with this filing letter:

1. A clean version of the revisions to the Services Tariff that were accepted with a flexible effective date in the CSR Order, with an effective date of December 15, 2021 (Attachment I);
2. A clean version of the revisions to the OATT that were accepted with a flexible effective date in the CSR Order, with an effective date of December 15, 2021 (Attachment II);
3. A clean version of Services Tariff Sections 23.2 and 23.3 to correct the effective date to March 31, 2021 in the eTariff system (Attachment III);
4. A clean version of OATT Section 30.14, with completed base, for the March 31, 2021 effective date (Attachment IV); and
5. A clean version of Services Tariff Section 13, with completed base, for the November 13, 2021 effective date (Attachment V).

II. Notice of Effective Date

In compliance with the CSR Order, the NYISO hereby provides notice to the Commission that it expects to implement the revisions to the Services Tariff and OATT that were accepted with a flexible effective date in the CSR Order on December 15, 2021.⁵ The revisions will become effective on December 15, 2021 in the Real-Time Market upon activation of the software enhancements supporting such revisions. For the Day-Ahead Market, the

Services Tariff revisions will be incorporated into the execution of the Day-Ahead Market occurring on December 16, 2021 for the December 17, 2021 Day-Ahead market day.

III. Service

The NYISO will send an electronic copy of this filing to the official representative of each party to this proceeding, to the New York State Public Service Commission, and to the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities. In addition, a complete copy of this filing will be posted on the NYISO's website at www.nyiso.com, and the NYISO will send an electronic link to this filing to the official representative of each of its customers and to each participant on its stakeholder committees.

IV. Conclusion

The NYISO respectfully requests that the Commission accept this compliance filing.
