Dear Ms. Bose:

In accordance with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's March 7, 2022 *Order on Compliance and Request for Waivers* ("March 2022 Order"), <sup>1</sup> The New York Independent System Operator, Inc. ("NYISO") hereby submits this compliance filing proposing revisions to Section 2.1.7 of the NYISO's Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT") and to Section 5.1.2 of the NYISO's Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff ("Services Tariff"). The proposed changes follow the Commission's directive to: (1) reference the Standards for Business Practices and Communication Protocols for Public Utilities adopted by the Wholesale Electric Quadrant ("WEQ") of the North American Energy Standards Board ("NAESB") Standards in the NYISO's tariffs precisely as amended by the Errata Notice issued March 3, 2020, and (2) add citations to the March 2022 Order granting the NYISO's waiver requests.

### II. EFFECTIVE DATE

NYISO requests that these proposed tariff revisions become effective on May 1, 2022.

### III. PROPOSED TARIFF REVISIONS

As required by FERC Order No. 676-I and the March 2022 Order, the NYISO is including Tariff revisions to update the identification of those WEQ standards incorporated by reference—or from which waiver was granted—by the Commission. Specifically, the NYISO seeks to revise Sections 5.1.2 of its Services Tariff and 2.17 of its OATT to (1) reference the WEQ Standards in the tariffs as amended by the Errata Notice issued March 3, 2020, and (2) include a citation to the March 2022 Order grating NYISO's waiver requests.

## IV. SERVICE

The NYISO will send an electronic copy of this filing to the official representative of each party to this proceeding, to the New York Public Service Commission, and to the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities. In addition, a complete copy of this filing will be posted on the NYISO's website at <a href="www.nyiso.com">www.nyiso.com</a>, and the NYISO will send an electronic link to this filing to the official representative of each of its customers and to each participant on its stakeholder committees.
