Re: Docket No. ER22-2154-00_, *New York Independent System Operator, Inc., et al.*; Compliance Filing to Submit Technical Corrections to Electronic Tariff Records

Dear Secretary Bose:

On June 21, 2022, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”), in its role as the administrator of the NYISO Open Access Transmission Tariff (“OATT”), submitted a filing on behalf of certain Transmission Owners in the above referenced docket (“June 21 Filing”).¹ The filing proposed: (1) the establishment of a new Rate Schedule 19 to the OATT; and (2) certain complementary revisions to Section 2.7 of the OATT.

On August 19, 2022, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) issued an order accepting the applicants’ proposal subject to certain compliance filing obligations (“August 19 Order”).² The August 19 Order directed the NYISO, in its role as the administrator of the OATT, to submit, on behalf of the applicants, certain technical corrections to the electronic tariff records included as part of the June 21 Filing.³ The NYISO submits this compliance filing to address the technical corrections described in the August 19 Order.

I. List of Documents Submitted

The NYISO submits the following with this filing letter:

1. A clean version of the proposed revisions to the OATT reflecting an effective date of August 22, 2022, as accepted by the August 19 Order (“Attachment I”).⁴

II. Description of Compliance Filing

The August 19 Order directed the NYISO, in its role as the administrator of the OATT, to submit certain technical corrections to the electronic tariff records that were included as part of the June 21 Filing.⁵ In compliance with such directive, the NYISO submits with this filing electronic records to reflect “clean” versions of the tariff revisions accepted by the August 19 Order. This compliance filing does not include any changes to the tariff revisions proposed in the June 21 Filing. Instead, this filing provides the requested electronic tariff records to accurately reflect the accepted tariff revisions within the Commission’s eTariff system.

III. Service

The NYISO will send an electronic copy of this filing to the official representative of each party to this proceeding, the New York State Public Service Commission, and the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities. In addition, a complete copy of this filing will be posted on the NYISO’s website at www.nyiso.com. The NYISO will also send an electronic link to this filing to the official representative of each of its customers, and each participant on its stakeholder committees.

IV. Conclusion

The NYISO respectfully requests that the Commission accept this compliance filing.
