Dear Ms. Bose:

In accordance with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's February 23, 2023 *Order on Compliance and Request for Waivers* ("February 2023 Order"),¹ the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. ("NYISO") hereby submits this compliance filing proposing revisions to Section 2.17 of the NYISO's Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT") and to Section 5.1.2 of the NYISO's Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff ("Services Tariff"). The proposed changes follow the Commission's directive to: (1) add citations to the February 23, 2023 Order granting the NYISO's waiver requests; and (2) correct the March 30, 2020 typographical error.

I. LIST OF DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED

Along with this filing letter, the NYISO submits the following documents:

1. a blacklined version of the NYISO's revisions proposed here to Section 5.1 of its Services Tariff, notating the revisions directed in the February 2023 Order and highlighting intermediate changes adopted into Section 5.1 of the Services Tariff with an effective date of May 1, 2022² (Attachment I);
2. a clean version of the NYISO's revisions proposed here to Section 5.1 of its Services Tariff (Attachment II);
3. a blacklined version of the NYISO's revisions proposed here to Section 2.17 of its OATT notating the revisions directed in the February 2023 Order and

highlighting intermediate changes adopted into Section 2.17 of the OATT with an effective date of May 1, 2022³ (Attachment III); and

4. a clean version of the NYISO's revisions proposed here to Section 2.17 of its OATT (Attachment IV).

II. EFFECTIVE DATE

NYISO requests that these proposed tariff revisions become effective as of February 23, 2023.

III. PROPOSED TARIFF REVISIONS

As required by FERC Order No. 676-J and the February 2023 Order, the NYISO is including Tariff revisions to update the identification of those WEQ standards incorporated by reference—or from which waiver was granted—by the Commission. Specifically, the NYISO seeks to revise Sections 5.1.2 of its Services Tariff and 2.17 of its OATT to (1) add citations to the February 2023 Order granting the NYISO's waiver requests; and (2) correct the March 30, 2020 typographical error identified by FERC in its February 2023 Order.

IV. SERVICE

The NYISO will send an electronic copy of this filing to the official representative of each party to this proceeding, to the New York Public Service Commission, and to the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities. In addition, a complete copy of this filing will be posted on the NYISO's website at www.nyiso.com, and the NYISO will send an electronic link to this filing to the official representative of each of its customers and to each participant on its stakeholder committees.
