Dear Secretary Bose:

On May 1, 2023, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”) submitted, in the above-captioned docket, its Compliance Filing addressing certain North American Energy Standards Board (“NAESB”) Wholesale Electric Quadrant (“WEQ”) business practice standards as set forth in Commission Order 676-J. After submitting its NAESB Filing, the NYISO became aware of errors in its filing letter and proposed tariff revisions. The NYISO respectfully submits the enclosed errata to correct those errors.

I. Errata

The NYISO proposes the following revisions to both the Open Access Transmission Tariff (“OATT”) and Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff (“Services Tariff”) sections:

- Services Tariff Section 5.1.2 is updated to: (i) reflect that the revisions are made pursuant to FERC Order 676-J, not FERC Order 676-I; (ii) remove the proposed waiver from WEQ-001-13.1.2 and add a proposed waiver from WEQ-001-13.2; and (iii) add language to make clear that WEQ-023 is being incorporated by reference except for those sections for which waivers are proposed.
- Both Services Tariff Section 5.1.2 and OATT Section 2.17 are updated to correctly reflect the numbering scheme, name, and correct versions for the applicable WEQ standards as set forth in FERC Order 676-J.

Further, NYISO’s OATT and Services Tariff revisions correctly reflect NYISO’s intention to continue its existing waiver from WEQ-001-24 and WEQ-001-25, but the accompanying filing letter failed to address that waiver request. To that end, NYISO requests

continued waiver of WEQ-001-24 and WEQ-001-25 as previously granted by the Commission.¹ WEQ-001-24 addresses consolidation of multiple physical transmission reservations. WEQ-001-25 addresses the resolution of conflicts between physical transmission service requests or reservations when the transmission system is “oversubscribed.” Neither standard is applicable to the NYISO as NYISO transmission customers do not expressly reserve physical transmission service.

Finally, the NYISO’s filing letter incorrectly stated that NYISO is seeking continued waiver from WEQ-001-18 and WEQ-001-19; these requirements have been renamed and are now correctly addressed in NYISO’s request for waivers from WEQ-023 in its initial filing letter and tariff revisions.

II. Documents Submitted with this Filing Letter

1. A redlined version of the NYISO’s Services Tariff Section 5.1 reflecting the changes described above (“Attachment I”);
2. A clean version of the replacement version of Section 5.1 incorporating the changes described above (“Attachment II”);
3. A redlined version of the NYISO’s OATT Section 2.17 reflecting the changes described above (“Attachment III”); and
4. A clean version of the replacement version of Section 2.17 incorporating the changes described above (“Attachment IV”).

III. Service

The NYISO will send an electronic copy of this errata to the NAESB Filing to the official representative of each party to this proceeding, to the New York Public Service Commission, and to the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities. In addition, a complete copy of this filing will be posted on the NYISO’s website at www.nyiso.com, and the NYISO will send an electronic link to this filing to the official representative of each of its customers and to each participant on its stakeholder committees.
