In accordance with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's October 26, 2023 *Order on Compliance and Request for Waivers*, <sup>1</sup> The New York Independent System Operator, Inc. ("NYISO") hereby submits this compliance filing proposing revisions to Section 2.1.7 of the NYISO's Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT") and to Section 5.1.2 of the NYISO's Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff ("Services Tariff"). The proposed changes follow the Commission's directive to add citations to the October 2023 Order granting the NYISO's waiver requests.
