**Re: Docket No. ER24-1655-00_, *New York Independent System Operator, Inc.*;
Notice of Effective Date for Tariff Amendments to Enhance Financial
Transaction Capabilities**

Dear Acting Secretary Reese:

On March 29, 2024, the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (“NYISO”) filed proposed revisions to its Market Administration and Control Area Services Tariff (“Services Tariff”) and its Open Access Transmission Tariff (“OATT”) (“March 29 Filing”).¹ The March filing included two distinct sets of tariff revisions, which were described and will be implemented independently. Relevant here, the first set of tariff revisions enhances financial transaction capabilities within the NYISO-administered wholesale Energy market by allowing Bilateral Transactions, or contracts, to sink at a Withdrawal-Eligible Generator that is located in the New York Control Area.

On May 29, 2024, the Director of the Division of Electric Power Regulation – East, acting pursuant to authority delegated by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, issued an order accepting the NYISO’s proposed tariff revisions (“May 29 Order”).² The May 29 Order accepted the NYISO’s request for a flexible effective date for the proposed revisions to enhance financial transaction capabilities within the NYISO-administered wholesale Energy market and directed the NYISO to submit a subsequent filing to specify the effective date for the proposed enhancements.³

I. Notice of Effective Date for Enhanced Financial Transaction Capabilities

In compliance with the May 29 Order, the NYISO hereby provides notice that it expects to implement the Services Tariff and OATT revisions related to enhancing financial transaction capabilities accepted by the Commission on June 18, 2024.⁴ Attachment I provides clean versions of the relevant Services Tariff and OATT revisions reflecting an effective date of June 18, 2024.

The NYISO will send an electronic copy of this filing to the official representative of each party to this proceeding, the New York State Public Service Commission, and the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities. The NYISO will also send an electronic link to this filing to the official representative of each of its customers, and each participant on its stakeholder committees. The revisions will then be incorporated into the execution of the Day-Ahead Market occurring on June 19, 2024, for the June 20, 2024 market day. Should the NYISO determine that it will be unable to implement the tariff revisions on June 18, 2024, it will promptly notify Market Participants and the Commission.
