Response to Deficiency Letter

Dear Acting Secretary Reese:

Central Hudson Gas and Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "Applicant") hereby submits its enclosed response to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission" or "FERC") letter requesting further information issued on May 6, 2024, in the above-referenced docket. This submittal supplements the filing the New York Independent System Operator, Inc. ("NYISO") made on Central Hudson's behalf on March 8, 2024.

I. Background

On March 8, 2024, the NYISO filed on behalf of Applicant and pursuant to Federal Power Act Section 205 and Part 35.13 of the Commission's regulations, proposed amendments to the NYISO Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT"). The amendments reflect the addition of a new Rate Schedule 21 to provide for Central Hudson's recovery of costs associated with the provision of Wholesale Energy Export Service and Wholesale Charging Service (together, "WDS Rates") to customers who own electric resources connected to Central Hudson's distribution system and sell the output of those resources through the NYISO administered wholesale markets, as well as customers charging electric energy storage systems for purposes of making wholesale sales

through the NYISO-administered wholesale markets.² Central Hudson's WDS Rates have been established in accordance with the calculation methodologies for Central Hudson's Standby and Buyback Rates approved in the New York Public Service Commission ("NYPSC") Standby Rates Order, with appropriate modifications.³ The March 8, 2024 submission provides further explanation, as does Central Hudson's April 15, 2024 Motion for Leave and Answer in the above-referenced proceeding.

On May 6, 2024, the Commission issued a deficiency letter requesting additional information concerning the Applicant's filing.
