## **VIA E-TARIFF FILING**

Dear Secretary Reese:

In accordance with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission" or "FERC")<sup>1</sup> Letter Order issued November 8, 2024 in the above-referenced proceeding approving Consolidated Edison Company. of New York, Inc.'s ("Con Edison") Joint Offer of Partial Settlement on Rate Schedule 10 submitted August 19, 2024 and the Joint Offer of Settlement on Rate Schedule 19 submitted August 20, 2024 ("Settlement"),<sup>2</sup> Con Edison respectfully submits this compliance filing to reflect certain revisions to its formula rate template related to the Return on Equity ("ROE") for Rate Schedule 10 and Rate Schedule 19 projects, as well as remove references to ROE incentive adders, as specified in Article 3.2(b) of the respective settlement agreements approved by the Commission.

This compliance filing modifies Con Edison's formula rate template contained in Section 6.19.8.2.2 of Attachment 3 to Rate Schedule 19 ("Formula Rate Template") to reflect the respective ROE values set forth in the Settlement for Rate Schedule 10 and Rate Schedule 19 projects. This compliance filing also modifies the Formula Rate Template to remove reference to prohibited incentive adders from Line 12 and Note C of Workpaper 10b10 and adds a Note Q on Appendix A to state that Rate Schedule 19 projects are not eligible for ROE incentive adders. These revisions ensure consistency with the Settlement concerning ROE incentive adders for Rate Schedule 10 projects and Rate Schedule 19 projects.

# **Background and Description of Filing**

On June 22, 2023, as amended on September 1, 2023, the NYISO submitted, on behalf of Con Edison, proposed revisions to the NYISO OATT in Docket No. ER23-2212. These revisions included Consolidated Edison's Formula Rate Template, associated formula rate protocols, and conforming tariff amendments to enable the derivation and recovery of costs for eligible transmission projects under Rate Schedule 19<sup>3</sup> and Rate Schedule 10 of the NYISO OATT.<sup>4</sup> Con Edison also requested a separate ROE ceiling value for Rate Schedule 19 and base ROE value for Rate Schedule 10 and sought a 50-basis point ROE adder for participation in a Regional Transmission Organization ("RTO Adder") for Rate Schedule 10.

On October 31, 2023, the Commission issued an order conditionally accepting Con Edison's filing.<sup>5</sup> The Commission approved the formula rate protocols and tariff amendments effective August 22, 2023, but subjected the Formula Rate Template to further compliance and suspended its effectiveness for a nominal period, subject to refund and pending hearing and settlement judge procedures.<sup>6</sup> Con Edison thereafter filed two settlements to address all outstanding issues:<sup>7</sup>

- 1. A Joint Offer of Partial Settlement ("Rate Schedule 10 Settlement") resolving issues related to the proposed ROE for Rate Schedule 10.
- 2. A Joint Offer of Settlement ("Rate Schedule 19 Settlement") addressing ceiling base ROE proposals under Rate Schedule 19.

On September 26, 2024, the Settlement Judge certified the Rate Schedule 10 Settlement and the Rate Schedule 19 Settlement to the Commission as uncontested settlements.<sup>8</sup> On November 8, 2024, the Commission issued the Settlement Order approving both settlements.<sup>9</sup> The Settlement Order directed

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Con Edison to make compliance filings for its formula rate template, including the following requirements:<sup>10</sup>

- Rate Schedule 10: Con Edison must incorporate the base ROE values for Rate Schedule 10 projects set forth in Appendix A of the Rate Schedule 10 Settlement as reflected by revisions to: (1) Line 4 and the addition of Note 1 on "Workpaper 6b10: Cost of Capital (Schedule 10 Projects);" and (2) Note C on "Workpaper 10b10: Schedule 10 Project ATRRs."
- Rate Schedule 10: Con Edison must remove specific references to prohibited ROE incentive adders, including Line 12 and Note C on "Workpaper 10b10: Schedule 10 Project ATRRs."
- Rate Schedule 19: Con Edison must incorporate the ceiling ROE value for Rate Schedule 19 projects set forth in Appendix A-1 of the Rate Schedule 19 Settlement as reflected by revisions to Lines 2, 6, 10, and 14 on "Workpaper 6a19: Cost of Capital (Schedule 19 Projects)" and other changes necessary to clarify that ROE incentive adders are not applicable for Rate Schedule 19 projects.

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filing to the official representative of each of its customers and each participant on its stakeholder committees.
